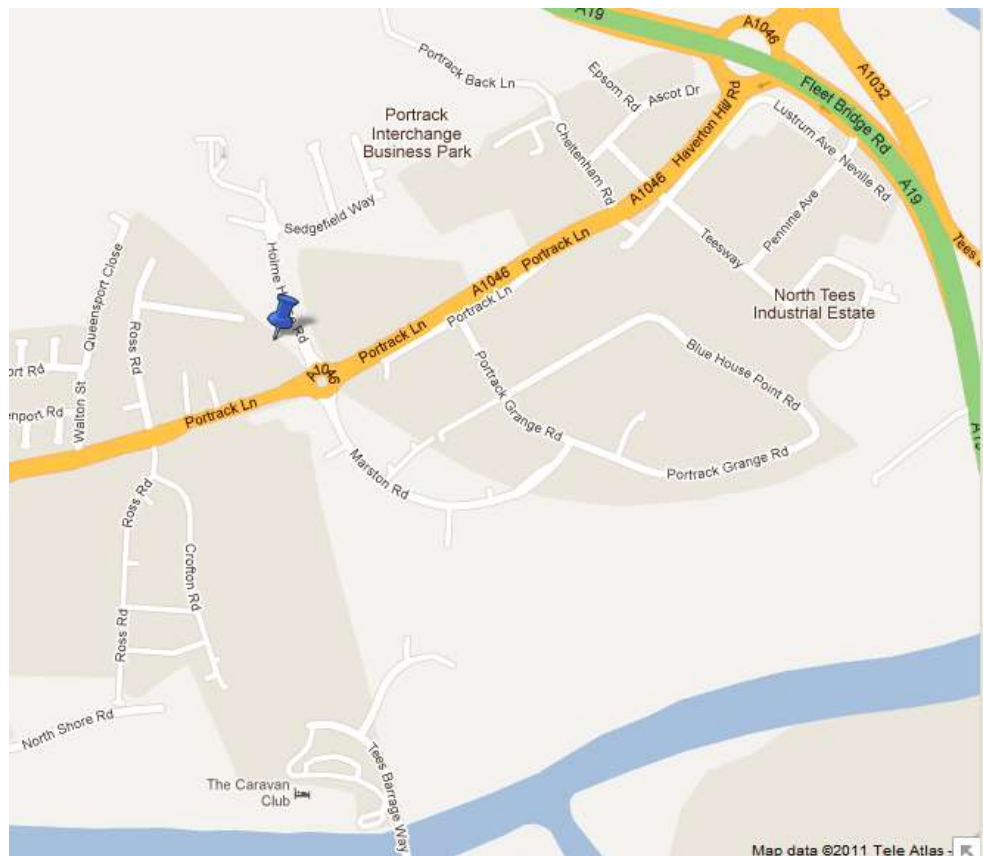

Big Lottery Fund (BIG) is the largest distributor of National Lottery Good Cause funding. Our money is distributed via a range of different funding programmes. This event will look at our two main open programmes highlighted below. Although BIG is unable to fund the promotion of any religion or belief system we understand that many faith and belief organisations carry out a wide range of community activities and good cause projects and we may be able to fund such activities.

- **Awards for All** funds organisations between £300-£10,000 for new project ideas that last up to 12 months in length.
- **Reaching Communities** funds organisations between £10,000-£500,000 for projects between 1 and 5 years in length.
- **Reaching Communities buildings** funds between £100,000-£500,000 for the development of generic community buildings that are open to a wide range of community groups and users.
