The pilgrimage is a 3 day walk from Rothbury to the Preaching Trees at Windyhaugh (access by kind permission of Jack and Sue Hislop and the Ministry of Defence). Each day there will be morning prayer and spiritual reflections while walking through beautiful Coquetdale. The average daily walk will be 7 miles sometimes over rough terrain. All walkers need to be able to cope with all terrains and have appropriate boots and waterproofs.

There will be limited accommodation in Tomlinson's Bunkhouse, Rothbury or there are several hotels or bed and breakfast establishments in the village. Transport will be by minibus. Walkers will meet at Rothbury URC on Friday 3 August for introductions and packed lunch prior to setting out on walk.

Each day's walk stands alone and anyone wishing to join the pilgrimage for one section would be very welcome. Children are also welcome to walk but there will be no special activities provided for them.

All those under 18 must have parental permission and be the responsibility of a named adult walker.
