IN THIS CHURCH ON TUESDAY 11th MAY 1971, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF ENGLAND RESOLVED TO UNITE WITH THE CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH IN ENGLAND AND WALES TO FORM THE UNITED REFORMED CHURCH. THIS UNION, WHICH TOOK PLACE ON 5th OCTOBER 1972, WAS THE FIRST BETWEEN SEPARATE DENOMINATIONS IN ENGLAND.
